Gather and Source

We gather and source food through individual and retail donations, food drives, and wholesale purchases.

Food Safety

We responsibly stock and store food in our warehouse. We follow strict food safety guidelines to ensure quality and safe food.

Prep and Pack

Volunteers and staff members sort, prepare, package, and deliver food through our 16 county service areas.

Network

We partner with 170 nonprofit organizations and programs to distribute food to those in need.

Nourish

We provide nutritious food and grocery items to families, children, individuals, and seniors to stock their shelves at home.
